Dear General Smith:

There remains in the category of unfinished intelligence business between our agencies the matter of agreement, under NSCIB 5, for coordination of agreed service espionage activities. I am sure you join with the services in wanting to get on with this matter.

We have been working earnestly on this in recent weeks and I feel the armed services can now present you with an agreement acceptable to you.

I should like to bring this proposal to you personally, at your convenience, and obtain from you, firsthand, your reaction to it. I feel we are so close to an accord that we can advance toward final formal action rapidly in this way.

In view of the similarity of our proposal to that outlined by you to the IAC on 24 April 1952, I feel that not more than 15 minutes should be required.
