



SUBJECT: Draft Report of the Joint Subsidiary Plans Division to the Joint Chiefs of Staff on Special Operations

SUMMARY

1. The U.S. representative on the Standing Group, NATO, requested guidance on:
 - a. Answering a request from SACEUR that they confirm what he considers to be his interest and responsibility in Clandestine Warfare.
 - b. A WUCC report to the S.G. on the necessity for determining appropriate targets for S.O. attack and liaison between the Clandestine Services and SACEUR.
2. The subject report was developed in several conferences between CIA representatives and JSPD, at which points of difference or questions were resolved to the satisfaction of both parties.
3. With the exception of two minor reservations indicated in proposed memorandum prepared for your signature, the report is believed to be satisfactory to CIA. Request that DCI sign.
