MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE:

Subject: Liaison Between the Central Intelligence Agency and the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

1. Reference is made to your recent discussion with the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff regarding the establishment of effective liaison to ensure that you are furnished such information as is in the hands of the Joint Chiefs of Staff that is essential in making your Intelligence estimates.
2. The Joint Chiefs of Staff have directed me to establish such liaison.
3. In order to facilitate satisfaction of your requirements, the Deputy Director of the Joint Staff for Intelligence (currently Brigadier General R. C. Partridge, USA) has been designated as the point of contact to receive those requirements. Subject of course to agreement concerning the "need to know", he will then provide such information as is within his area of primary interest, and ensure provision of that outside his area directly to you by the other Deputy Director of the Joint Staff concerned, through the Secretary, Joint Chiefs of Staff, when appropriate.
4. This procedure is not intended to interfere with the direct liaison between the Central Intelligence Agency and the Chief of the Joint Subsidiary Plans Division who will continue to provide military collaboration with the Office of Policy Coordination, nor is this intended to affect arrangements under which you deal directly with the respective Services in matters which are peculiarly theirs.
5. If, at any time these arrangements should fail to work out satisfactorily, I shall be prepared to assist.
