MEMORANDUM FOR CHAIRMAN, JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF

SUBJECT: Overseas CIA Logistical Support Bases

1. Reference is made to memorandum (SM-1196-53) from the Deputy Secretary, Joint Chiefs of Staff, dated 18 June 1953, concerning the above subject. We agree that review by the Joint Chiefs of Staff is appropriate and necessary in any final CIA requirements which are determined by the responsible military service to be beyond the scope of existing logistical support policies. In this respect, our requirements have been reduced materially since our memorandum to you of 12 December 1952, and no major problems are anticipated in the present coordinated planning being conducted between this Agency and the military services.



1. This is to acknowledge the memorandum of the Secretary, Joint Chiefs of Staff, dated 18 June 1953 (ref. a) regarding Department of Defense support to this Agency in the establishment of overseas CIA Logistical Support Bases. We concur that review by the Joint Chiefs of Staff is appropriate and necessary in any final Agency requirements which are determined by the responsible military service to be beyond the scope of existing logistical support policies.

2. In this respect the requirements of CIA have been reduced materially since our memorandum of 12 December 1952 (ref. b) to the extent that it is not anticipated that any major problems will develop in the present coordinated planning being conducted between this Agency and the various military services of the Department.
