1. Subject named officer has expressed his intention to submit his resignation from the U. S. Navy in order to accept career employment with the Central Intelligence Agency. This memorandum is designed to formalize the substance of the conversations on this matter between Mr. Walter Reid Wolf, Deputy Director for Administration, Central Intelligence Agency, and Vice Admiral J. L. Holloway, USN, the Chief of Naval Personnel; and to present facts underlying the desire of the Central Intelligence Agency that [redacted] be made available for career civilian employment.

2. The facts referred to above are:

a. That the Central Intelligence Agency has an unusual interest in such rare cases involving extraordinary qualifications for highly specialized clandestine intelligence activities.

b. That, during his tour of duty with the Central Intelligence Agency, [redacted] has developed his ability and demonstrated his proficiency for the more sensitive type of clandestine intelligence activity to a remarkable degree. Further, that his experience as [redacted] his facility


