SUBJECT: [redacted] Attendance at Moral Re-Armament Congress

1. [redacted] Office, has been requested to attend the World Assembly for Moral Re-Armament, to be held at Mackinac Island, Michigan, from 25 September to 5 October 1954.

2. It is understood, from delegates to that Congress, that [redacted] can be expected to encounter expenses in Mackinac which will be considerably in excess of normal per diem allowances.

3. It is accordingly recommended that [redacted] while acting as your representative at this Congress, be allowed travel and maintenance expenses on a cost basis.

4. It is necessary for [redacted] to perform this travel on an all-expense basis since he will be required to stay in the Grand Hotel at a cost of \$13.27 per day (American Plan) and pay a registration fee of \$10.00 on arrival. Any entertainment required will be reimbursable by the Agency, and [redacted] will be required to submit a full accounting of his expenses upon his return.
