Dear Senator Brewster:

In response to your request, dated 8 December 1947, for certain information regarding the civil aviation of leading foreign countries, I am pleased to deliver to you fifteen copies of a special CIA study on the subject. This study was previously prepared for the President's Aviation Advisory Commission. In substance, it corresponds so closely with your outlined request that it is believed it will completely fulfill your needs. An organizational outline has been added for each country in compliance with your request. The short deadline established precluded development of other separate studies.

It will be noted that certain sections of the study are classified "Secret" which makes it necessary to accord the entire study the security handling appropriate to that classification. Each section may be used separately, of course, in accordance with its classification.

It is believed desirable that all copies of the study be returned to the Central Intelligence Agency when they have served your purpose. It will, therefore, be appreciated if you notify me when you have finished with them, and I will be happy to arrange for their return.

It is a pleasure to serve you, and I trust that the information meets your requirements.



Dear Admiral Hillenkoetter:

The work of the Congressional Aviation Policy Board would be greatly assisted if you would provide our Subcommittee on Government Organization, of which Senator Capehart is Chairman, with the following information, which is understood to be in your possession, regarding the governmental organization and control of civil aviation in the leading foreign countries:

1. Organization charts.
2. Channel of responsibility, i.e., to whom, and through whom, is the head of the department or agency responsible.
3. The relationship between the aeronautics rule-making agency; rule-enforcement agency; certificating agency and rate-making agency.
4. Conflicts or over-lapping of the functions of the aviation agency with other government agencies.

It would be extremely helpful if we could secure fifteen copies of this material by December 11, in order that it may be considered prior to the next meeting of the Committee. In the event the desired information is presently embraced in a compilation or report in your possession, it is requested that such compilation or report be furnished this Committee.
