Dear Mr. Busbey:

I am enclosing a brief statement of the pertinent background of each individual listed in your letter of 19 August, together with an indication of their capabilities. I trust that the information I have furnished will meet your needs.

The separation of certain of the individuals listed has presented a difficult problem due to governing Civil Service laws and regulations. However, when the CIA comes into existence under the provisions of the recent act of Congress, it will be possible to obtain more expeditious action whenever warranted.

May I take this opportunity to remind you that the information you indicated you would furnish with regard to the disloyalty of certain employees has not been received and would be much appreciated so that it may be considered in connection with the security investigations of the individuals concerned.

Please do not hesitate to call upon me at any time for any service or information which I may be able to give you.
