Dear Senator Hayden:

This is in reference to your letter of 9 January 1954, in behalf of [redacted] who is interested in employment with this Agency.

In order that we may have a complete record of [redacted] back-ground for our review, it is requested that you have him complete and return the enclosed forms to us. When these have been received in our Personnel Office, you may be assured that his application will be given careful consideration, and we shall be glad to advise you when a decision has been made in this case.

As [redacted] is currently employed with another U. S. Government agency, it will be necessary for him to obtain a letter of availability from his present employer before we can discuss employment possibilities with him. It is the policy of CIA to consider employees of other Government branches only with prior consent of the branch concerned.
