
Dear Mr. Dulles:

Resolution

BIDDING FOR CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE
AGENCY TO LOCATE A NEW OFFICE
BUILDING WITHIN THE GREENBELT AREA

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland that the Central Intelligence Agency has under consideration several sites for the proposed C.I.A. building, one of which sites is located within the corporate limits of the City of Greenbelt, and

WHEREAS, Said site is part of the 1160 acre tract now owned by the United States Government and under the jurisdiction of the Department of the Interior, having been transferred to said department for park land from the Public Housing Administration, and

WHEREAS, Said C.I.A. building site would require only a small segment of this now unimproved Government-owned land, and

WHEREAS, Said proposed Greenbelt site is adjacent to the new Washington-Baltimore Parkway, and along the new dual lane Edmonston Road, and within a half-mile of the proposed Inter-County Belt Freeway, making it one of the most accessible sites in the entire Washington metropolitan area, and

WHEREAS, Said Greenbelt site is virtually the hub of extensive residential development, either now under construction or in the advanced planning stages, now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Council of the City of Greenbelt instruct the City Manager to prepare letters to His Honor, Theodore R. McKeldin, Governor of the State of Maryland, to Senators John Marshall Butler and J. Glenn Beall, to Congressman Richard Lankford, and to Mr. Allen Dulles, Director of the Central Intelligence Agency, setting forth the advantages of the proposed Greenbelt site, and requesting an interview with the officials in charge of selecting the site for the proposed C.I.A. building.
