


Section 3(c) of H. R. 3882 is, with some minor language changes, identical with certain provisions of Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950. The provisions of Section 3(c) were originally included in the Internal Security Act of 1950 at the request of CIA in order to protect certain intelligence sources and methods in the field of foreign intelligence which I am charged by law to protect. Therefore, as Section 3(c) is a re-enactment of Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950, which is presently on the statute books, we are anxious to have it continued in the present bill.


