Thank you for your letter of 23 March 1955, with which you enclosed the application of [redacted] for employment with this Agency.

[redacted] application has been referred to our Personnel Office, and you may be assured that it will be given careful consideration. However, I note that she is particularly interested in obtaining a position [redacted], and I must inform you that the Agency does not hire directly for an overseas assignment. CIA normally requires a headquarters assignment of approximately two years before sending its employees overseas, and even then we would not be able to guarantee a specific country or area.
