Dear General Walters:

I thought that you might like to have the attached lists of the friends and colleagues who participated in presenting Doctor Fritz Kraemer with a Wilkinson Sword and a suitably engraved book of statements of appreciation at the dinner in his honor on 3 July. Your own message was a valued part of the book.

We have finally gotten together the bills and receipts for the evening; copies are attached. The total cost of the sword (\$250.00), engraving of the placque (\$13.00) and the engraved book (\$36.55) was \$299.55; prorated among the 31 participants it amounts to about \$9.66 each.

The total bill from the Fort McNair Mess came to \$739.20 for the 39 servings, which (at \$18.88 prorated) is somewhat more than the original estimate; the surprisingly high bar bill accounts for the difference. I have had this rechecked, but the club asserts that we did indeed drink that much! Four of the 39 were our guests (Dr. and Mrs. Kraemer and Mr. and Mrs. Bryant), whom some of us will wish to take care of in the final adjustment.

I have paid or assumed responsibility for all bills. Your check, made out to me and sent in the enclosed envelope, would be the simplest way of handling your participation.
