BMD AIRBORNE ASSAULT VEHICLE WHICH WAS INITIALLY DEPLOYED IN 1972 AS REPLACEMENT FOR OLDER ASSAULT GUNS IN SOVIET AIRBORNE UNITS, AND MAY EVENTUALLY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR THE PT-76 LIGHT TANK IN RECONNAISSANCE UNITS. IT IS ARMED WITH THE 76MM GUN AND THE SAGGER MISSILE SYSTEM, IS AIR DROPPABLE AND PROBABLY HAS A CBR PROTECTIVE SYSTEM. Y

C. BTR-60 PB ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIER WHICH IS IMPROVED VERSION OF THE BTR-60 P WHICH FIRST APPEARED IN 1961. THIS APC IS ARMED WITH TWO MACHINE GUNS AND CAN CARRY UP TO ELEVEN MEN. DOES NOT HAVE CBR PROTECTION CAPABILITY.
