3. General Walters asked that I raise the issue with Mr. Bush in case he desires to mention General Walters' schedule to Scowcroft. If the Director prefers, I can mention it to Bill Hyland.

[redacted] did advise Hyland's office of Gen. Walters itinerary. You might wish to mention his European trip in the event there is a "sensitive task" for the General to perform on behalf of Dr. Kissinger or the White House - especially in [redacted]

Also, you should be aware that Sec'y Rumsfeld's office called evening 15 April to request secure line contact between Rumsfeld and Walters. When informed Walters would be in [redacted] on Saturday and back in DC on Monday, Rumsfeld cancelled the call.
