Dear Mr. Dulles:

Reference is made to your telephone call of June 24, 1952, to this office, wherein you advised that one [redacted] had arrived at New York City and had been questioned by either the Federal Bureau of Investigation or representatives of a Congressional Committee. 25X1

We are now in receipt of information that [redacted] was questioned by representatives of the Senate Subcommittee on Internal Security in Executive Session on Sunday, June 22, 1952, at 9:40 a.m., in the United States Customs Office, Idlewild Airport, New York City, with Senator Arthur V. Watkins presiding. A copy of the transcript of [redacted]'s testimony given at this Executive Session has been transmitted to the Department from Senator McCarran's office. 25X1

A review of the transcript reveals that [redacted] therein states, among other things, (a) that there were two conferences at which he, [redacted], and Mr. John Paton Davies were present; (b) that at both of these conferences, in addition to himself, [redacted] and Davies, there were also present another representative of the State Department, and two or three representatives of the CIA, one of the latter being his [redacted] immediate supervisor at that time; (c) that after each of the two conferences, memoranda were written for Central Intelligence files, concerning what had transpired and that one of the two memoranda had been written by [redacted] and the other by himself. 25X1

It will be appreciated if, at your earliest convenience, you would advise the Department whether the other CIA representatives whom [redacted] says attended the conferences in addition to himself and [redacted] are available for interview. In addition, 25X1
