SUBJECT: Interference with Radio Reception

1. You may be assured that every effort will be made to insure that the radio operations of the Central Intelligence Agency in Temporary Y Building will not interfere with the activities now being conducted by the Immigration and Naturalization Service.

Prior to implementation, any plans for installation or operation in this area of equipment which might seriously affect the radio operations of the Immigration and Naturalization Service will be carefully considered and discussed with either Mr. Walls and Mr. Wadden of your office for their concurrence.
