Dear General:

Thank you for your letter of August 14th, with its generous offer to increase the number of copies of reports sent to us from your headquarters. This offer is especially welcome because we have been finding it very difficult to satisfy our several divisions with the small number of copies now received.

We'd like very much indeed to receive seven copies each of the followings:

- ATIS Interrogation Reports (published as compilations bearing upon specific subjects)
- ATIS Interrogation Reports (the green-bordered reports on current POW's)
- ATIS Bulletins (on Preliminary Examination of Documents)
- Daily Intelligence Summary
- CIC District Field Reports

All five of the above series are extremely useful to us, and I shall be most grateful if you can meet our need for seven copies. The first of the Bulletins on Captured Documents have just come through, and it is already evident that they are going to be a most useful source of information on many different scores.

In accordance with your request, we have recently sent to the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, GSUSA, four copies of as many of our earlier publications on the Far East as were available. In a few instances we have been obliged to send less than four copies, due to depletion of reserve stocks. These should be coming to you from G-2, GSUSA, within the near future and I hope that they will be of value to you.
