

My dear Reverend Dunning:

Your letter of December 15th seeking our help in a program you are preparing has been brought to my attention. I think you will understand that the Central Intelligence Agency does not as a matter of policy sponsor or even suggest individuals who might be able to make public appearances in connection with programs of the sort you are planning, and of course we are not in a position to vouch for the affiliations of individuals who may have been behind the "Iron Curtain."

May I suggest that you try some private association of exiles or displaced persons such as the National Committee for a Free Europe in New York which maintains extensive contacts with reputable individuals with the background you seek? Possibly they will be able to suggest someone for your purposes.


Gentlemen:
