

General Smith has asked that I reply to your kind letter of 2 June 1951, in which you compliment the Central Intelligence Agency and General Smith in particular.

The law is most explicit in stating that we do not have any internal security duties or responsibilities. These belong to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
