1. A friend of mine who is attached to the HICOG wrote me the following:

"You will undoubtedly be familiar with the shady figure of ex-General Major Remer. He is now suing one of the senators of the city of Bremen for libel because the senator accused Remer of betraying the 20th July conspiracy. Defense counsel in the case, the very reputable Bremen lawyer Dr. Lifschuetz, has asked me for help in obtaining the interrogation report of the Army Intelligence interrogation of Remer in 1945. The document is allegedly somewhere in the Pentagon. I have, of course, referred Dr. Lifschuetz to the U. S. Land Commissioner in Bremen but would also like to ask you for help, since the outcome of this libel suit might be politically rather important. Perhaps someone in your office could make a few inquiries."

2. Have you any ideas how we could get our hands on the document to which he refers?
