

25X1 MEMORANDUM TO [redacted]

25X1 [redacted] called Wednesday, 15 November, in an effort to clarify the status of his cousin, [redacted] who is at present employed in one of [redacted]

25X1 It appears that [redacted] attempted to obtain a position with the Central Intelligence Agency sometime ago. There was apparently no vacancy for him and he considered the matter closed. The individuals he contacted in CIA on this occasion were [redacted] and [redacted]

25X1 At some later date when he accepted the position in [redacted] he was contacted by another group in CIA (apparently Office of Operations) and asked if he would perform certain functions for the CIA while in [redacted]. He advised whoever contacted him that he had at one time applied for a position with the Central Intelligence Agency but was told that he could best serve the Agency by accepting the position in [redacted]

25X1 Recently he has received a rather cryptic wire directing him to come back to the United States to work for the Agency. He believes this wire must have originated from his original contact [redacted] [redacted] who possibly had no knowledge that he was already performing some service for another staff in CIA.

25X1 [redacted] has moved his family to [redacted] is pleased with his present position and does not wish to return to the United States at this time unless it is necessary.

This information was relayed to [redacted]

25X1 This probably accounts for its sketchiness and incompleteness. However, I have assured [redacted] that I would try to obtain a firm decision as to what CIA wants [redacted] to do and that I would advise [redacted] of this by telephone in the near future.
