Dear Mr. Dulles:

In connection with the last world developments I permit myself to remind you on our brief conversation in your office in June 1950, and also to point out some remarks.

1. a) It seems to me that it is now a last moment for concentration of all ~~all~~ efforts on the only one decisive and important sector - Russian. It is obvious that Communist Dictatorship in Moscow menacing the whole world could not be stopped but must be destroyed. It is clear also that this could be done only by Russian hands with mighty American assistance on world-wide scale.

b) It is tragedy that up to now we have no Russian anti-communist action sponsored by the United States. Not for secondary tactical defensive tasks of today, but as military-political cadres for strategic mission using inner vulnerability of the Soviet Union. I know that this bold and yet unpopular action is difficult because of the left-wing experts on Russian affairs, but it is a strategic emergency.

2. I am afraid that all strategic calculations about eventual assistance by Tito's "32" divisions are dangerously wrong. I do not know whether that comes as a result of lack of information, desinformation or even provocation, but I am sure that they will NOT fight against Soviets..

I continue

I appreciate this work, but I do not feel that it is a best use of my background and experience at these critical times. Some of friends of mine from overseas reproach my political "passivity" strongly. They are not aware about the conditions in the United States, but they are right that it is a last moment for an anti-communist contre-offensive, (or for preparation for such offensive..)
