General Wedemeyer has given me a statement of your education and experience, and has indicated that you are interested in possible employment with the Central Intelligence Agency.

The background presented in your statement is certainly broad and unusual, and indicates qualifications which might be of value to us. However, it is our policy not to employ individuals who are not citizens of the United States. For this reason it will not be possible to consider your employment at this time.

If you are still interested when you become a naturalized citizen we will appreciate hearing further from you at that time. We will then be able to give full consideration to your joining us, dependent, of course, upon the availability of a suitable position within the organization and other processing factors involved.

I wish to express my appreciation for your interest in the Central Intelligence Agency and your desire to join the organization.
