

SUBJECT: Terms of Reference for the Psychological  
Strategy Plan Prescribing Specific Courses  
of Action with Respect to Germany

Enclosed herewith for your information are Terms of Reference for the Psychological Strategy Plan Prescribing Specific Courses of Action with Respect to Germany, PSB D-21/1, dated March 21, 1952. TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AD HOC PANEL "F"


I. The Problem:

To devise a national psychological strategy plan to provide for:  
(a) the integration of Western Germany into Western Europe, (b) the reduction of Soviet capabilities in Eastern Germany, (c) the achievement of German unity, and (d) the role of a unified Germany in the unification of Europe.

II. Objectives:

- A. To facilitate the integration of Western Germany into Western Europe.
- B. To contribute to making Eastern Germany a strategic liability to the Soviet Union.
- C. To support the unification of East Germany with a West Germany which is a reliable member of the Western Community.
- D. To create the psychological conditions for bringing about this union within the framework of a future European community.
- E. To allay the fears and suspicions of Germany's neighbors, both Eastern and Western, with respect to German unification.
