MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN, PSYCHOLOGICAL STRATEGY BOARD

SUBJECT: Fourth Report on Working Group (Stalin) (PSB D-40/1)

WGE reviewed contingencies in the Korean situation and made preliminary recommendations for the development of positions by State and Defense.

Suggestions for current tactics in implementation of the strategic concept of PSB D-40, and the follow-up of the President's speech, have been assembled and a paper is being circulated which is intended to embody general tactical principles. To avoid giving the impression that a U.S. iron curtain opposes Soviet "peace" moves, the Group suggested that the visa policy of the U.S. with regard to Soviet orbit nationals be reviewed in the light of the present situation.

The psychological implications of U.S. foreign economic policy particularly in the free world, have been analyzed and specific recommendations made to you in brief form.
