MEMORANDUM to The Psychological Strategy Board

SUBJECT: PSB D-23 "U. S. Psychological Strategy Based on Thailand"

Attached is a draft revision of this paper, prepared in consultation with the member agencies in accordance with NSC Action No. 884, for consideration at the PSB meeting of September 2.

The revisions drafted to correspond with the comments of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the changes proposed by the Central Intelligence Agency are principally concerned with relative emphasis on Thailand and Indochina; this is reflected in the proposed change in the title of the paper, and throughout the Phase I portion. There have also been changes in assignment of tasks due to the reorganization and separation of the International Information Administration into the operationally independent United States Information Agency.

There has been some delay in the preparation of a completed Financial Appendix as required by the NSC Action. I hope to forward this separately before the PSB meeting.
