SUBJECT : Items for Discussion, PSB Informal Meeting, 3 June 1953

1. Item 1: [redacted] Ideas. You will remember that in last week's briefing I suggested the possibility that [redacted] would like to have [redacted] present his ideas at this week's meeting. Apparently [redacted] has decided against having [redacted] make the presentation in person and will give a brief statement himself.

2. PSB Support for Ambassador Lodge. At the informal meeting on 9 April the general question of psychological support for Ambassador Lodge at the UN General Assembly was discussed (see Item 5 of minutes), and it was felt generally to be a good idea to furnish this support. Subsequently, Dr. Craig and Mr. Wallace Irwin of the PSB staff have been interviewing various people in the UNA section of the State Department and at the U. S. delegation. The matter will be brought up tomorrow by [redacted] who is expected to ask General Smith for his opinion as to "how" the question of "who should do what" should be formalized.
