MEMORANDUM OF INFORMAL PSB MEETING, APRIL 30, 1953. (There was no meeting on 7 May)

Place: Office of the Director of Mutual Security.

Present: Messrs. Jackson, Smith, Kyes, Dulles, Stassen
and Morgan.

Agenda Item 1. Recent Soviet and Satellite interests in non-strategic trade with the West was discussed. It was pointed out that the matter needs careful consideration in relation to the whole complex of East-West trade policy. If possible, a comprehensive plan should be developed which would enable the President to take the initiative.

Agenda Item 2. Mr. Stassen described two major contributions by MSA. I reported that staff work on relating the President's immigration request to this item was making good progress.

Agenda Item 3. Pertinent information was exchanged.

Agenda Item 4. With regard to the possibility of food for Hungary, the letter from Minister Ravndal to Mr. Jackson was cited, and I was asked to continue staff investigations, keeping in mind that we should feed our friends, such as Pakistan, first, that offers to only one Satellite country would raise difficulties in connection with others, and that it might be desirable to try for reinstatement of CARE or other private relief agencies.
