Abstracting and coding of intelligence information

1. OSI concurs with the recommendations set forth in paragraph 5 of your memorandum, subject, "Agency Activities Relating to Abstracting and coding of Intelligence Information," dated 16 September 1949. It is urged that these recommendations be implemented without delay inasmuch as OSI has been attempting, for some time, to find a solution to the abstracting and coding problem.
