Subject: Coordinated Exploitation of Enemy Document Repositories Relating to Political-Social-Psychological Warfare.

1. At the first meeting of the designated departmental representatives with members of the Interdepartmental Coordinating and Planning Staff held on 4 December 1946 to explore the possibilities of the coordinated exploitation of enemy document repositories relating to political-social-psychological warfare, it was agreed that:

a. Requirements for material bearing on this subject would be prepared in outline form, and visits made on each agency and the Librarian of Congress for the purpose of making an overall survey of the documents available in Washington.

b. Departmental representatives would make inquiries from their overseas document sources to obtain estimates of material available abroad.

c. A second meeting would thereafter be called to consider the problem in the light of information gained.

2. It is understood that the provisions of the agreement reached at the first meeting have now been completed. Accordingly, it is requested that the same representatives be directed to meet for the second time with members of the Interdepartmental Coordinating and Planning Staff at 1400, 17 January, 1947, in Room 2178, New War Department Building, 21st and Virginia Avenue, N.W. The representatives designated at the IAB meeting on 26 November 1946 who attended the first meeting were:
