SUBJECT: Requested Information about Material Distributed to the FBI.

DATE: 1 March 1960

1. In response to your recent request, the following is a report of the kinds of material distributed to the FBI.

## a. Finished Intelligence:

- (1) One copy of each "Weekly Summary".
- (2) One copy of each issue "Monthly Review of the World Situation".
- (3) One copy of each Map Division Publication of the "M" Series.
- (4) One copy of each Map Research Bulletin of the "MR" Series.
- (5) One copy of each publication in the "ORE Estimates Series".
- (6) One copy of each publication in the "ORE Situation Report Series".

## b. Raw Intelligence:

Very little raw intelligence is forwarded to the FBI because it is felt that their needs are better served by the finished evaluated product of the CIA. However, we send from three to eight CIA Information Reports a month to the Bureau. These reports are selected, according to their importance to the FBI Mission, and deal with such subjects as the following:

- (1) Crime.
- (2) Illegal shipments.
- (3) Illegal entry or residence in the USA.
- (4) Arrival and departure of Soviet agents, known and suspected communists and aliens of doubtful repute.
- (5) Counterfeiting of US currency and negotiables.
- (6) Subversive activities within the USA.

## c. Citations of intelligence reports of other agencies:

The OCD advises the FBI from time to time of the existence of reports, issued by other agencies, which, by reason of their substance, are important to the mission of the FBI. No actual reports are transmitted or divulged, but several reports are cited each month.
