1. Reference is made to paragraph 8 g of Appendix "A", 304/1, revised 30 April 1947:

"8 g. Under authority of this charter, request the presence at committee meetings, as consultants, of representatives from the policy and functional offices of the State, War, or Navy Departments, and the Central Intelligence Group."

The SANACC Subcommittee on Special Studies and Evaluations desires to avail itself of the channels of the SANACC Secretariat to transmit an invitation through the Civil Affairs Division of the Army to Brigadier General Robert A.
