1. An economic agreement to provide for the denationalization of Jewish-owned properties in Poland has reportedly been reached between the Polish Government and the Keren Kayemet (Jewish National Fund).
2. It is believed that the beneficiaries of the agreement will be the Keren Kayemet and the Hebrew University. These institutions have allegedly undertaken the task of registering the properties according to the two categories provided for by the agreement; i.e., properties owned by Jews now residents of Palestine and properties owned by Jews who died in Poland.
3. Lucsan Horowic, of the Ministry of Trade and Industry, and Isaac Gruenbaum, head of the Labor Department of the Jewish Agency, have allegedly been conducting the negotiations, which were evidently initiated by Gruenbaum when he visited Poland in June and July 1947. It is believed that Gruenbaum was to have gone from Poland to Switzerland to continue negotiations and to find a discreet form of transfer of reparation funds for the properties involved.

25X1A6a [redacted] Gruenbaum is [redacted] having difficulty because of his persistence in advocating terrorism suppression. He is said to have had a serious split with the Jewish Agency Executive, mainly with Ben Gurion, chairman of the Executive. Although Gruenbaum's resignation from the Agency was rumored, the General Zionist organization has given to the press information that Gruenbaum was not resigning, but rather, was departing for Europe to work in the Displaced Persons camps.

 4. [redacted] the Polish Consulate in Tel Aviv has transferred to the Polish-Palestine Friendship Society a lecture hall and canteen at 96 Hayarkon Street, Tel Aviv, formerly used by the propaganda section. In connection with this transfer of property, two members of the Polish-Palestine Friendship Society, Anselm Reiss and Dr. Chaim Drabkin, Secretary of the Achud Avoda, are expected to go to Poland.
