The weapons and ammunition plant in Cugir, which manufactured sewing machines and bicycle chains for the Soviet Union until recently, now makes cartridge cases for ammunition of all calibers, especially 8.8 mm. Barrels and clips for automatic weapons are also produced. This production is secret. Some workmen who talked about their work among themselves were punished by deportation as forced laborers for the construction of the Danube River-Black Sea Canal.
