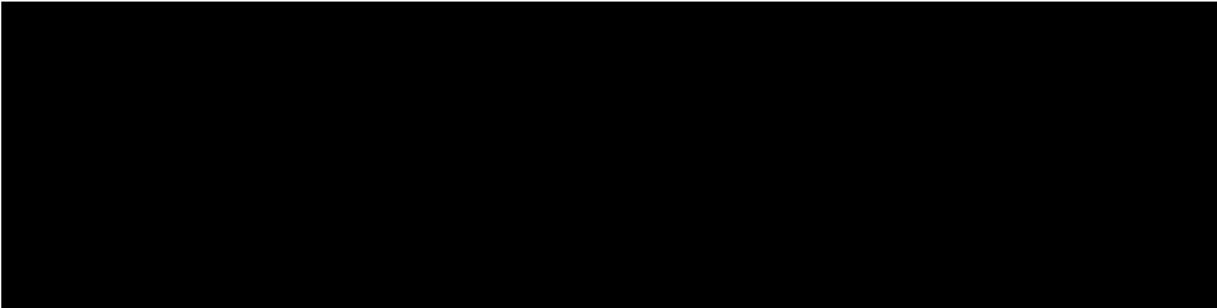

1. Greek refugees who have been settled in southern Macedonia are very discontented with their existence there despite the efforts made on their behalf by the Skoplje Government. Without exception, these Greeks would prefer to return to Greece if they were granted an amnesty and given assistance in rebuilding their homes and farms which, for the most part, have been burned down or partially destroyed.
2. The nationalist movement in Macedonia currently has very little following. The older generation have remained either pro-Serb or pro-Bulgarian, and although a majority of the younger generation recognize Macedonian nationalism, it is disunited in this ideology.
