The following information was offered [redacted] as refutation of an article in Nationen, 12 July 1951, which stated that Soviet radio amateurs had gone off the air.

Soviet amateur radio traffic has been normal. [redacted]

Other

[redacted] radio amateurs had also been in contact with Soviet amateurs in the Balkans (sic; Baltic?). The communication was about weather and similar topics, as usual between amateurs. The traffic from Soviet amateurs in the period 12-26 July may have been a bit lower than usual, but it was never completely absent.
