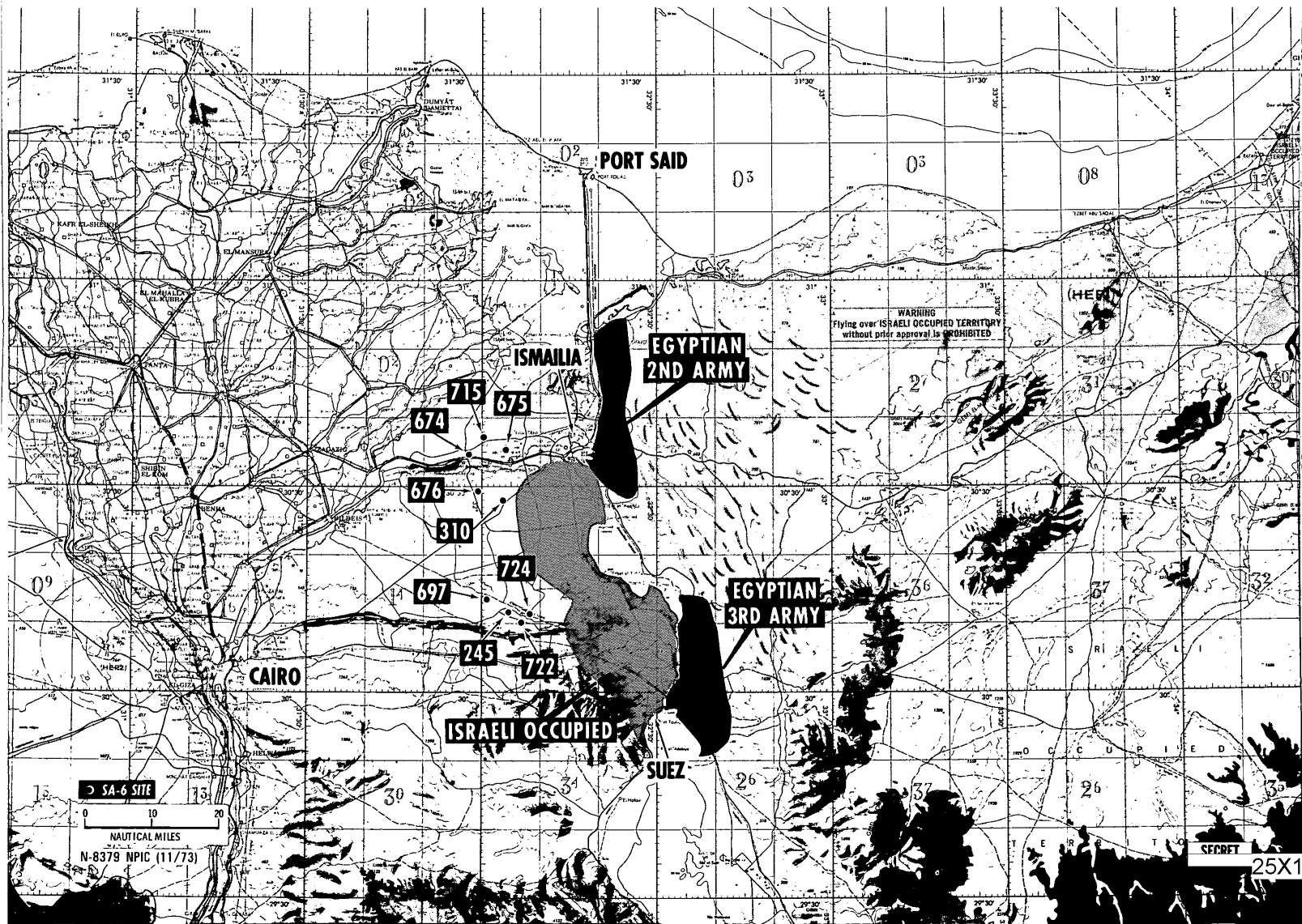

3. MISSION READOUT: SA-6 EQUIPMENT OCCUPIED PREVIOUSLY KNOWN NPIC SITES 245, 674, 675, 676, 697, AND 715.

AT SITE 245, THE SA-6 EQUIPMENT WAS COLLOCATED WITH DUMMY SA-3 EQUIPMENT. THE FOUR LAUNCH REVETMENTS AND THE GUIDANCE AREA CONTAINED DUMMY SA-3 EQUIPMENT. A STRAIGHT FLUSH RADAR WAS IN ONE OF THE LAUNCH POSITIONS CONTAINING DUMMY SA-3 MISSILES. FOUR SA-6 TRANSPORTER-ERECTOR-LAUNCHERS (TELS) WERE UNRETTED AND DISPERSED AROUND THE SITE. TWO SA-6 TRANSLOADERS WERE ALSO PRESENT.

SITES 722 AND 724 WERE NEW, OCCUPIED SA-6 SITES. SITE 722, 23 NAUTICAL MILES (NM) WEST-NORTHWEST OF AS SUWAYS, CONSISTS OF FOUR REVETTED LAUNCH POSITIONS, A REVETTED GUIDANCE AREA AND TWO TRANSLOADER-HOLD REVETMENTS. SA-6 EQUIPMENT INCLUDED FOUR SA-6 TELS, TWO SA-6 TRANSLOADERS, AND ONE STRAIGHT FLUSH RADAR.

SITE 724, 24 NM WEST-NORTHWEST OF AS SUWAYS, CONSISTS OF FOUR PRIMARY REVETTED LAUNCH POSITIONS, A PRIMARY REVETTED GUIDANCE AREA, AND TWO PRIMARY TRANSLOADER-HOLD REVETMENTS. AT LEAST SIX SA-6 MISSILES, FOUR SA-6 TELS, TWO SA-6 TRANSLOADERS AND ONE STRAIGHT FLUSH RADAR WERE OBSERVED. A COMPLETE SECONDARY SITE IS INTERLACED WITH THE PRIMARY SITE AND WAS UNOCCUPIED.

SA-6 EQUIPMENT WAS ALSO OBSERVED NEAR SITE 310.
