Approval of Minutes

1. Action: The minutes of the last meeting, 15 May 1952 (IAC-M-70) were approved.

Procedures for Reducing Intelligence Deficiencies in National Intelligence Estimates (16 May 1952)

2. Action: "General Smith stated that the identification of intelligence deficiencies in our production, including the conduct of post-mortems on estimates, was an essential part of the intelligence process. It was agreed that the IAC representatives should proceed to produce jointly statements of intelligence deficiencies on estimates in appropriate cases. Statements of intelligence deficiencies will be sent by the Director of Central Intelligence to members of the IAC for appropriate action. "

Specific Intelligence Support for NATO (IAC-D-45/9)

3. Action: Disapproved the request from the U.S. Member Intelligence Committee, Standing Group, NATO to table in the Standing Group estimate of the number of Soviet Atomic Bombs available in stockpiles in six-month periods to the end of 1954, ~~unless the JCS states that such information is absolutely essential to NATO military planning.~~

Revised

Critical National Intelligence Objectives with Respect to Communist China (IAC-D-50)

4. Action: Agreed that the Interdepartmental Priorities Committee should prepare for IAC consideration a statement of critical national intelligence objectives with respect to Communist China in response to the JIC request, it being understood that such statement might be an amendment to DCID 4/2 or a separate paper as appropriate.
