

Secretary's Note \

1. All of the IAC agencies having concurred, the name of the Intelligence Working Group (IWG) was changed to Economic Defense Intelligence Committee (EDIC), effective 26 October 1954. (IAC-D-53/6, 15 October 1954)

2. No objection having been raised by an IAC member, the Secretary has authorized the release to the USIA of NIE 11-4-54 "Soviet Capabilities and Probable Courses of Action through Mid-1959"



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4. The Secretary proposes to release 
RIR-2, "Anti-Communist Resistance Activities and Potential in Communist China," with the deletions from the text noted in the ONE memorandum of 1 November 1954. This release will be authorized after the IAC meeting of 9 November unless a member raises an objection at that time.

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
