




1. Action: Approved.

3. Discussion: The DCI expressed his doubt that this reporting procedure was useful. He proposed that the present report go forward and that the problem then be taken up with the appropriate NSC personnel. It was brought out by discussion that these reports are requested by the NSC Executive Secretary, the President having directed that the departments responsible for national security programs prepare reports on the status of those programs semi-annually. The current report is the seventh produced since July 1951.



8. Action: Agreed that the Members would study the proposal circulated by General Willems at the meeting and telephone their concurrence or comments to the Office of National Estimates.

Matters for NSC Briefing

9. Discussion: The DCI stated that the Council might be interested in the pictures of alleged Soviet aircraft currently appearing in the press. A paper prepared for the JCS was made available to the Director. Mr. Dulles undertook to examine, with Air Force assistance, the source of such photographs, said to have been available to certain publishers over the past four years.
