b. Noted the findings of the post-mortem on this estimate.

7. Presentation of NIE's

a. Mr. Kent noted that the recently completed survey on the use of NIE's had indicated that high-level consumers of NIE's, particularly in staff briefings, frequently relied principally on summaries of the conclusions or text of NIE's, which did not necessarily incorporate IAC-approved language. He raised the question of whether an attempt should be made to include in future estimates an additional shorter set of conclusions specifically designed to anticipate the needs of such consumers.

b. The members agreed that, as an experiment beginning with the next estimate, and until advised otherwise by the IAC, the Board of National Estimates should include in drafts of estimates submitted for IAC approval an additional set of conclusions, which would not exceed one page in length.

8. Special Briefing

At 1135 General Gaither and his assistants presented before a limited group a special briefing on a matter which had been previously considered by the Watch Committee.

9. Executive Session

At 1150, pursuant to the request of General Lewis, the members remained for an executive session, at which Mr. Dulles presided.

He stated that, in his opinion, it was the best and most comprehensive report on intelligence requirements with respect to the USSR which he had seen, and represented a substantial step forward.
