

SUBJECT: Examination of Intelligence Community Performance
Regarding the Soviet Military Presence in Cuba

The Senior Review Panel, assisted by Rear Admiral W. D. Robertson, USN-Retired, has completed its examination of Intelligence Community performance regarding the Soviet military presence in Cuba. Most of its recommendations are in the direction of a more active effort to deal with intelligence analysis and production on a Community basis. These recommendations merit consideration and I plan to discuss them at a forthcoming NFIB meeting. 
