LONDON — "Thunderball" director Terence Young is having problems with the British Official Secrets Law over his next picture, "The Eddie Chapman Story."

Chapman was in jail in Guernsey for safe-cracking when the Germans captured the Channel islands. He offered to work for them on condition he was freed. They sent him to Berlin to learn the spy business, then parachuted him into England, whereupon he made straight for British intelligence, told them his

story and offered to be a counterspy for England. Young hopefully bought the tale many years ago, but the government is against the disclosure of departmental secrets. Terence is making the movie — but in France.
