OSWALD and LSD

Lee Harvey Oswald, the assassin of President John F. Kennedy, may have been one of those given LSD in a CIA test program in the late 1950s and early '60s, Rolling Stone magazine contends. "If Oswald was sent to Russia on some covert task, then it's quite possible that he was given LSD as part of his training." Oswald, some believe, may have been a U.S. agent while in the Soviet Union, and the CIA, the article claims, often administered LSD to agents who were destined for dangerous overseas missions so they could experience the drug.
