Cirulis, Janis

Janis Cirulis served in the Latvian Self-Defense forces from June to September 1941 when those forces were used to round up Jews and suspected Communists. From September 1941 to September 1944, he served in the Latvian Political Police, the indigenous counterpart of the Gestapo in Latvia.
