Reference is made to your memorandum dated March 4, 1958, your reference CS CI 748 091, in which you requested clearance for passage to the German Intelligence Service of certain information set out in our memoranda of August 23, 1957, and September 23, 1957. - DFB - 9/15/44

A review of the data set forth in your memorandum has been compared with the information included in our memoranda of August 23, 1957, and September 23, 1957, and it is noted that in order to report more clearly and accurately the data furnished by our sources, the following changes should be made:

1. On page one in paragraph two after "Dainauskas" in line two, should be inserted the phrase "on August 14, 1957."
2. On page three in paragraph one, the words "dated in either June, July or August, 1957," should be used in place of "dated the Summer of 1957."

4. On page four in the first full paragraph, word four in line one should be "Latar."

If the above changes are made and if this Bureau is not divulged as the source of the information, we have no objections to the passage of the information to the German Intelligence Service.
