SUBJECT: Khafer DEVA, aka Cafer DEVA, aka Djafer DEVA; January 1954 Visit to Istanbul

1. Subject arrived by air from Rome, Italy, on 9 January 1954,* and registered at the Park Hotel, Istanbul, where he remained two days. Afterwards he moved to Pendik, a small town on the Asiatic shore of the Sea of Marmara, about 10 miles from Uskudar, a suburb of Istanbul, where he is currently staying with his brother, Ismail DEVA, a Wagon-Lits inspector.

* According to official arrival and departure lists furnished us by [] Subject possesses a new Italian passport #4643119, issued in Rome on 5 December 1953, in which his occupation is given as that of a manufacturer.

2. Since his arrival in Istanbul Subject has had a few contacts with [] and has also a number of times visited Nedship MUSA (Serbo-Croatian spelling: Nedjip MUSA), Subject of Ref J, and MUSA's close friend Serif QHMEDE, at their apartment in Fatih, Zuleli Cesme Sokak, Ipek Apt. #2, Istanbul, usually as their dinner guest. Inasmuch as MUSA had been Subject's body-guard during the period from 1942 to 1944 while Subject was the Albanian Minister of the Interior, and had only recently arrived in Turkey, these visits were quite likely of a personal nature, though they might easily involve an attempt at recruiting MUSA for intelligence activities.
3. With the exception of the contacts listed in paragraph 2 above, Subject is not known to have made any other contacts, either with Albanians or others, though it is expected that he will make some before he leaves for Rome.
