1. Paul DICKOPF, an interned political refugee, was interviewed a few days ago and, to begin with, gave the following information concerning himself.

2. German. Born 9.6.10 at Hatter near Wiesbaden. Kriminal Kommissar of the Kripo at Frankfort a/Main and Karlsruhe after October 1939. Held the same post in Ast Stuttgart. Gave up his post the summer of 1942 for political reasons; in July 1943 fled through Belgium and France to Switzerland.

3. Subject gave the following list of Leiters for Ast Stuttgart:
1940: Oberst SERVAES. Later head of Ast Dijon, then Brussels.
End of 1940 to end of 1941: Oberstleutnant ZEITZ, a former Saar industrialist. Died.
He was followed by Oberstleutnant HEUSER, formerly of Ast Prague and Athens.
Abteilung I: Major SCHMIDT. Nazi.
" II: Major Freiherr v. STAUFFENBERG, a relative of the well-known Stauffenberg. Opportunist and Nazi.
Abteilung III: Major MEYER. CE.
Hauptmann WAASER. Foreign intelligence. Known to informant.

4. We have prepared a questionnaire for the next interview. Although the information is old, it appears to be authoritative, hence of some value.
