1. I proclaimed the news of your presence in Hamburg to CARAVEL on 29 October 1957 at a routine meeting. He immediately dialled Rolf HOLLE, whom you will remember as Chief of Abteilung Inland, and passed the news on. HOLLE remarked that he expected to be in Hamburg in the next weeks and would call on you. CARAVEL said that he also hoped to be in Hamburg before long, would also call on you, and added a warm invitation for you to call on him when you are in this area.

2. I did not specifically suggest a visit to Hamburg of CARAVEL and wife at your expense, since his wife has recently returned from a visit to her parents, is still convalescing from her operation, and will not be travelling until some time after they move into their new apartment, as they are now scheduled to do on 19 November 1957. But I shall raise this point very soon, preferably in the lady's presence.

3. As you know, I have transferred to FOB and am now handling CARAVEL from there, so that contact with the CARAVELS will be more frequent than heretofore.
